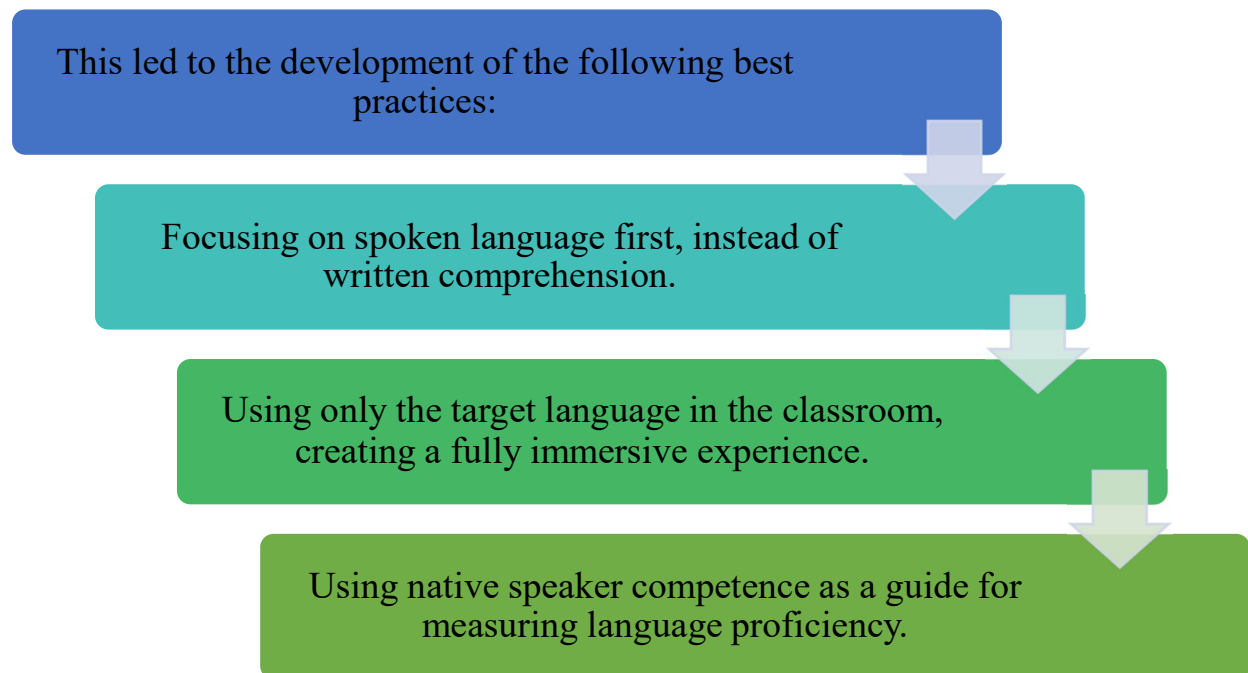


Fig. 1. Henry Sweet and Otto Jefferson: Pioneers of Language Learning in the 19th Century

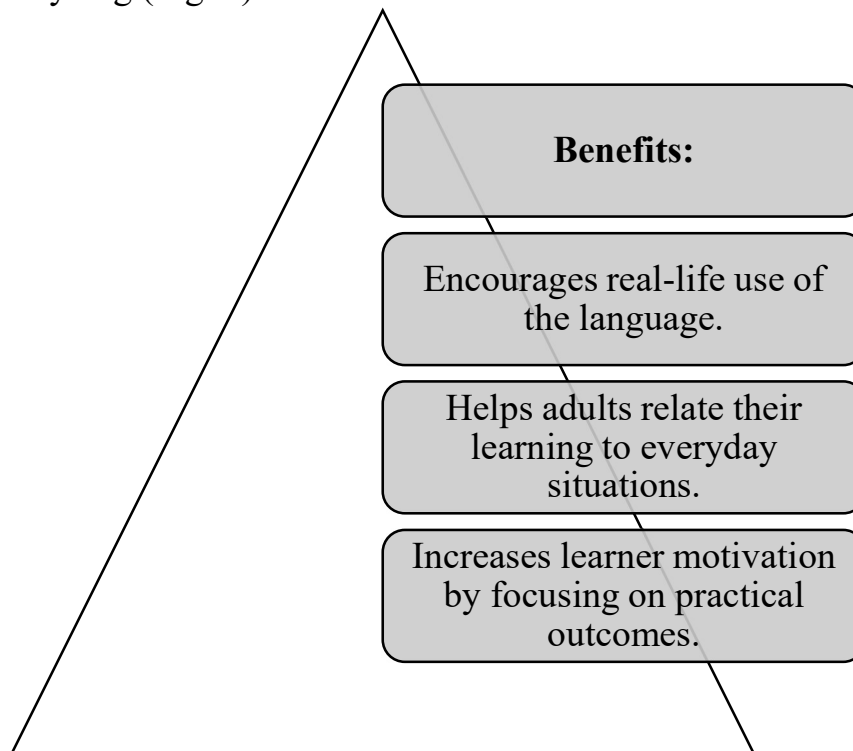


Fig. 2. Task-Based Learning (TBL)

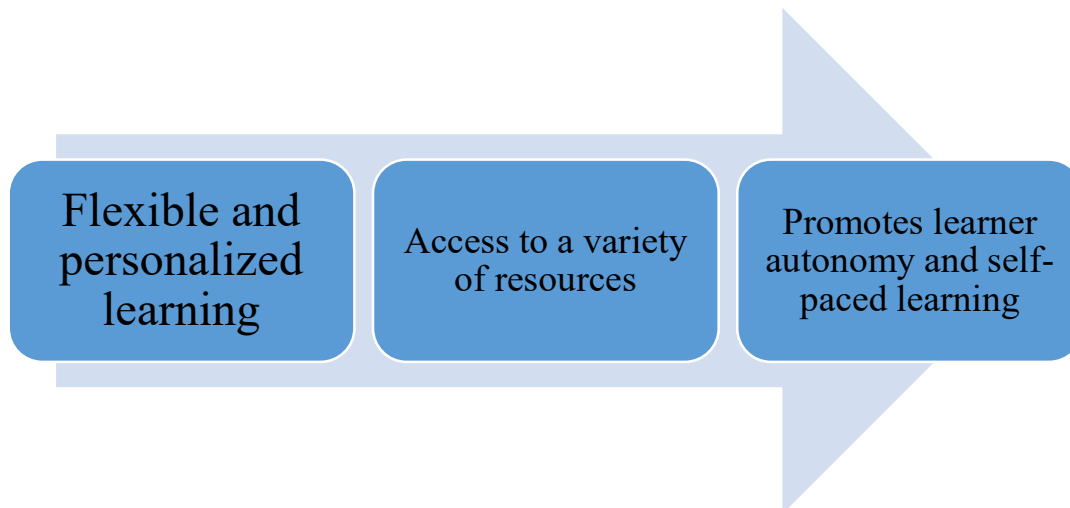


Fig. 3. Blended Learning

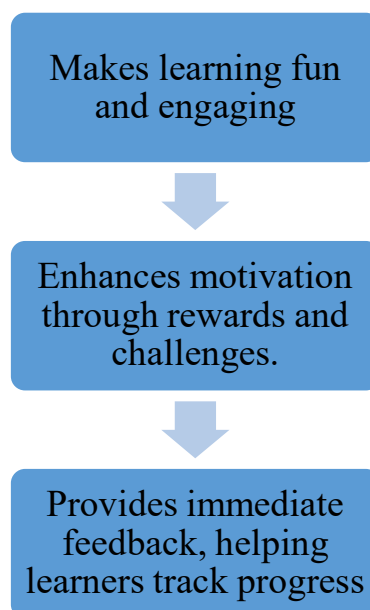


Fig. 4. Gamification
